

# SENATE BILL No. 1104

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Senator MACGREGOR and referred to the Committee on Veterans, Military Affairs and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 260, entitled

"An act to revise and codify the laws relating to blind persons and persons with a visual disability; to create a commission; to prescribe its powers and duties and those of other state agencies relative to blind persons; to provide services, education, training, and assistance to blind persons; to regulate concessions operated by blind persons; to transfer powers, duties, functions, and appropriations; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 10 (MCL 393.360).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 10. (1) This act ~~shall~~**DOES** not apply to a concession  
2       operated in connection with ~~the state fair, with the~~**ANY OF THE**  
3       **FOLLOWING:**

4               (A) **THE** use of state fairgrounds. ~~with a~~

5               (B) **A** state educational institution. ~~with a~~

6               (C) **A** state penal institution. ~~with a~~

1 (D) A military establishment. ~~7~~

2 (E) AN armory. ~~7-08~~

3 (F) A VETERANS' FACILITY. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION,  
4 "VETERANS' FACILITY" MEANS A LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY AND ANCILLARY  
5 FACILITIES FOR VETERANS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.

6 (G) A state park.

7 (2) A sighted person operating a concession under contract or  
8 lease ~~at the time this act becomes effective shall~~ ON OCTOBER 1,  
9 1978 **MUST** not be required to surrender the rights before the  
10 contract or lease expires.

11 (3) A sighted person operating a concession ~~which~~ **THAT** has not  
12 been applied for by a blind person may be permitted to continue in  
13 charge until the concession is applied for and a qualified blind  
14 person is chosen to operate the concession.

15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
16 after the date it is enacted into law.
