SENATE BILL No. 1139

November 8, 2018, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, KOWALL, GREGORY and CONYERS and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803b (MCL 257.803b), as amended by 2015 PA 78.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803b. (1) The secretary of state may issue 1 personalized
- 2 vehicle registration plate that shall be used on the passenger
- 3 motor vehicle, pick-up truck, motorcycle, van, motor home, hearse,
- 4 bus, trailer coach, or trailer for which the plate is issued
- 5 instead of a standard plate. Personalized plates shall bear letters
- 6 and numbers as the secretary of state prescribes. The personalized
- 7 plates shall be made of the same material as standard plates. A
- 8 personalized plate shall not be a duplication of another
- 9 registration plate.
 - (2) An application for a personalized registration plate shall be submitted to the secretary of state under section 217.

- 1 Application THE APPLICANT SHALL ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION for an
- 2 original personalized registration plate shall be accompanied with
- 3 payment of a service fee of \$8.00 for the first month and of \$2.00
- 4 per month for each additional month of the registration period in
- 5 addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. A-THE APPLICANT
- 6 MAY OBTAIN A second duplicate registration plate may be obtained by
- 7 requesting that option on the application and paying an additional
- 8 service fee of \$5.00. The SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEPOSIT THE
- 9 original and duplicate service fees shall be deposited in the

- 14 fee of \$15.00 in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee.
- 15 The SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CREDIT THE service fee shall be
- 16 credited to the Michigan transportation fund established under, and
- 17 THE STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT shall be allocated ALLOCATE THE
- 18 SERVICE FEE as prescribed under, section 10 of 1951 PA 51, MCL
- 19 247.660. The STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT SHALL USE THE amount
- 20 allocated to the state trunk line fund established under section 11
- 21 of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.661, shall be used by the state
- 22 transportation department for litter pickup and cleanup on state
- 23 roads and rights of way.
- 24 (3) The expiration date for a personalized registration plate
- 25 shall be—IS as prescribed under section 226. Upon the issuance or
- 26 renewal of a personalized registration plate, the secretary of
- 27 state may issue a tab or tabs designating the month and year of

- 1 expiration. Upon the renewal of a personalized registration plate,
- 2 the secretary of state shall issue a new tab or tabs for the rear
- 3 plate designating the next expiration date of the plate. Upon
- 4 renewal, the secretary of state shall not issue the owner a new
- 5 exact duplicate of the expired plate unless the plate is illegible
- 6 and the owner pays the service fee and registration fee for an
- 7 original personalized registration plate.
- 8 (4) The SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT GIVE A sequence of
- 9 letters or numbers or combination of letters and numbers on a
- 10 personalized plate shall not be given to a different person in a
- 11 subsequent year unless the person to whom the plate was issued does
- 12 not reapply before the expiration date of the plate.
- 13 (5) An applicant who applies for a registration plate under
- 14 section 217d, 803A, 803e, 803f, 803j, 803k, 803l, 803n, or 803o is
- 15 eligible to request, and the secretary of state may issue, the
- 16 registration plate with a sequence of letters and numbers otherwise
- 17 authorized under this section.
- 18 (6) The secretary of state may issue a temporary permit to a
- 19 person who has submitted an application and the proper fees for a
- 20 personalized registration plate if the applicant's vehicle
- 21 registration may expire prior to receipt of his or her personalized
- 22 registration plate. The temporary registration shall be-IS valid
- 23 for not more than 60 days after the date of issuance. The SECRETARY
- 24 OF STATE SHALL ISSUE THE temporary permit shall be issued without a
- 25 fee.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
