## **SENATE BILL No. 1154**

November 8, 2018, Introduced by Senator ROCCA and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
by amending section 411 (MCL 436.1411), as amended by 2014 PA 44.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 411. (1) SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION AND
- 2 SECTION 537, A BREWER OR MICRO BREWER MAY SELL BEER IT MANUFACTURED
- 3 FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES AT AN APPROVED TASTING ROOM
- 4 UNDER SECTION 536 IF THE TASTING ROOM IS LOCATED ON LICENSED
- 5 BREWERY PREMISES WHERE THE BREWER OR MICRO BREWER MANUFACTURES.
  - (2) THE SALE OF BEER UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS SUBJECT TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS:
  - (A) A brewer that is not licensed as a micro brewer may sell its beer for on-premises consumption at not more than 2 locations

- 14 a brewer or micro brewer has more than 1 licensed brewery premises,
- 15 that brewer or micro brewer may sell for on-premises consumption
- 16 beer that it has produced at 1 licensed brewery premises at AN
- 17 APPROVED TASTING ROOM LOCATED ON any of its other licensed brewery
- 18 premises IF 1 OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS IS MET:
- 19 (A) THE LICENSED BREWERY PREMISES THAT RECEIVES THE BEER, ON
- 20 WHICH THE APPROVED TASTING ROOM IS LOCATED, HAS AN INSTALLED AND
- 21 FUNCTIONAL MULTIVESSEL SYSTEM CAPABLE OF PRODUCING AND FERMENTING
- 22 AT LEAST 3 BARRELS OF WORT IN A SINGLE BATCH.
- 23 (B) THE LICENSED BREWERY PREMISES THAT RECEIVES THE BEER, ON
- 24 WHICH THE APPROVED TASTING ROOM IS LOCATED, PRODUCES A VOLUME OF
- 25 BEER EQUIVALENT TO 50% OF THE VOLUME OF BEER SOLD TO CONSUMERS AT
- 26 THAT TASTING ROOM.

WHICH THE APPROVED TASTING ROOM IS LOCATED, SUBMITTED AN 1 2 APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE AT THAT LOCATION BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2018. (3) As used in this section, "engages in the production of 3 4 beer" means the full and complete brewing process and not just a 5 portion of the brewing process. Enacting section 1.
