SENATE BILL No. 1202

November 27, 2018, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, GREGORY and CONYERS and referred to the Committee on Banking and Financial Institutions.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 218a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 218A. (1) A PERSON WHO DOES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING AND WHO
- 2 KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT THE DOCUMENT IS FORGED OR
- 3 GROUNDLESS, CONTAINS A MATERIAL MISSTATEMENT OR FALSE CLAIM,
- 4 CONTAINS A SIGNATURE THAT IS NOT THE SIGNATURE OF THE PERSON WHOSE
- 5 NAME IS BEING SIGNED, OR IS OTHERWISE INVALID MAKES A FALSE
- 6 REPRESENTATION CONCERNING TITLE AND IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 7 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR AND NOT MORE
- 8 THAN 5 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH:
 - (A) CLAIMS AN INTEREST IN, OR A LIEN OR ENCUMBRANCE AGAINST,

- 1 REAL PROPERTY IN A DOCUMENT THAT IS RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE

- 9 WHERE THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED.
- 10 (D) ROBOSIGNS A DOCUMENT OR CAUSES A DOCUMENT TO BE
- 11 ROBOSIGNED.
- 12 (2) A PERSON WHO MAKES A FALSE REPRESENTATION CONCERNING TITLE
- 13 IN 2 OR MORE TRANSACTIONS ENGAGES IN A PATTERN OF MAKING FALSE
- 14 REPRESENTATIONS CONCERNING TITLE AND IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 15 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS AND NOT MORE
- 16 THAN 20 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$50,000.00, OR BOTH, IF
- 17 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO THE TRANSACTIONS:
- 18 (A) THE TRANSACTIONS HAVE THE SAME OR SIMILAR PATTERN,
- 19 PURPOSES, RESULTS, ACCOMPLICES, VICTIMS, OR METHODS OF COMMISSION,
- 20 OR ARE OTHERWISE INTERRELATED BY DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS.
- 21 (B) THE TRANSACTIONS ARE NOT ISOLATED INCIDENTS WITHIN THE
- 22 PRECEDING 4 YEARS.
- 23 (C) THE AGGREGATE LOSS OR INTENDED LOSS IN THE TRANSACTIONS IS
- 24 MORE THAN \$250.00.
- 25 (3) IN ADDITION TO THE CRIMINAL PENALTIES IMPOSED UNDER
- 26 SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2), A PERSON WHO MAKES A FALSE REPRESENTATION
- 27 CONCERNING TITLE AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) IS SUBJECT TO A

- 1 CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION. A CIVIL
- 2 FINE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE RECOVERED IN A CIVIL ACTION
- 3 BROUGHT IN THE NAME OF THIS STATE BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL. THE
- 4 ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY RECOVER REASONABLE ATTORNEY FEES AND COSTS IN
- 5 AN ACTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 6 (4) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), THE OWNER OR HOLDER
- 7 OF THE BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF
- 8 A FALSE REPRESENTATION CONCERNING TITLE AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION
- 9 (1) MAY BRING A CIVIL ACTION TO RECOVER ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED BY THE
- 10 OWNER OR HOLDER OF THE BENEFICIAL INTEREST, REASONABLE ATTORNEY
- 11 FEES, AND COSTS. ADDITIONALLY, A PERSON WHO MAKES A FALSE
- 12 REPRESENTATION CONCERNING TITLE BY ROBOSIGNING UNDER SUBSECTION
- 13 (1) (D) IS LIABLE TO THE OWNER OR HOLDER OF THE BENEFICIAL INTEREST
- 14 IN THE PROPERTY FOR 3 TIMES THE AMOUNT FOR WHICH THE PERSON WOULD
- 15 OTHERWISE BE LIABLE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 16 (5) BEFORE BRINGING A CIVIL ACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (4), THE
- 17 OWNER OR HOLDER OF THE BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN THE REAL PROPERTY
- 18 SHALL REQUEST IN WRITING THAT THE PERSON WHO MADE THE FALSE
- 19 REPRESENTATION RECORD A DOCUMENT THAT CORRECTS THE FALSE
- 20 REPRESENTATION. IF THE PERSON RECORDS A CORRECTIVE DOCUMENT WITHIN
- 21 20 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE WRITTEN REQUEST, THE OWNER OR HOLDER
- 22 OF THE BENEFICIAL INTEREST IS NOT ENTITLED TO FILE A CIVIL ACTION
- 23 UNDER SUBSECTION (4).
- 24 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ROBOSIGN" MEANS TO SIGN A
- 25 DOCUMENT FOR THE SIGNOR OR TRANSFEROR.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
