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SENATE BILL No. 1216

November 27, 2018, Introduced by Senator COLBECK and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend 1982 PA 162, entitled

"Nonprofit corporation act,"

by amending section 209 (MCL 450.2209), as amended by 2014 PA 557.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 209. (1) The articles of incorporation may contain any
- 2 provision that is not inconsistent with this act and not expressly
- 3 prohibited by any other statute of this state, including, but not
- 4 limited to, any of the following:
- 5 (a) A provision for management of the business and conduct of
- 6 the affairs of the corporation, or creating, defining, limiting, or
- 7 regulating the powers of the corporation, its directors, officers,
- 8 members, or shareholders, or a class of directors, shareholders, or
- 9 members.
 - (b) A provision that under this act is required or permitted
- 11 to be set forth in the bylaws.

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- 1 (c) A provision that eliminates or limits a director's or
- 2 volunteer officer's liability to the corporation, its shareholders,
- 3 or its members for money damages for any action taken or any
- 4 failure to take any action as a director or volunteer officer,
- 5 except liability for any of the following:
- 6 (i) The amount of a financial benefit received by a director
- 7 or volunteer officer to which he or she is not entitled.
- 8 (ii) Intentional infliction of harm on the corporation, its
- 9 shareholders, or members.
- 10 (iii) A violation of section 551.
- 11 (iv) An intentional criminal act.
- 12 (v) A liability imposed under section 497(a).
- 13 (d) For a corporation whose purposes, structures, and
- 14 activities are exclusively those described in section 501(c)(3) of
- 15 the internal revenue code of 1986, 26 USC 501, a provision that the
- 16 corporation assumes all liability to any person other than the
- 17 corporation, its shareholders, or its members for all acts or
- 18 omissions of a volunteer director occurring on or after January 1,
- 19 1988 incurred in the good faith performance of the volunteer
- 20 director's duties.
- 21 (e) A provision that the corporation assumes the liability for
- 22 all acts or omissions of a volunteer director, volunteer officer,
- 23 or other volunteer occurring on or after the effective date of the
- 24 provision that grants limited liability if all of the following are
- 25 met:APPLY:
- 26 (i) The volunteer was acting or reasonably believed he or she
- 27 was acting within the scope of his or her authority.

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- 1 (ii) The volunteer was acting in good faith.
- 2 (iii) The volunteer's conduct did not amount to gross
- 3 negligence or willful and wanton misconduct.
- 4 (iv) The volunteer's conduct was not an intentional tort.
- 5 (v) The volunteer's conduct was not a tort arising out of the
- 6 ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle. for which tort
- 7 liability may be imposed under section 3135 of the insurance code
- 8 of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3135.
- 9 (f) A provision that reserves to 1 or more members,
- 10 shareholders, or other persons all or part of the authority to
- 11 exercise the corporate powers or to manage the business and affairs
- 12 of the corporation, including the resolution of any issue about
- 13 which there exists a deadlock among directors, shareholders, or
- 14 members. A provision authorized under this subsection that limits
- 15 the discretion or powers of the board relieves the directors of,
- 16 and imposes on the person or persons in which the discretion or
- 17 powers are vested, liability for acts or omissions imposed by law
- 18 on directors to the extent that the discretion or powers of the
- 19 directors are limited by the provision. The person or persons in
- 20 which the discretion or powers are vested are treated as a director
- 21 or directors for the purposes of any limitation or assumption of
- 22 liability under this section and, except as otherwise provided in
- 23 the articles of incorporation or bylaws, have the same rights and
- 24 obligations with respect to indemnification as a director or
- 25 directors.
- 26 (2) If the articles of incorporation contain a provision that
- 27 eliminates the liability of a volunteer director or volunteer

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- 1 officer that was filed before the effective date of the amendatory
- 2 act that added this subsection, JANUARY 15, 2015, that provision is
- 3 considered to eliminate the liability of a director or volunteer
- 4 officer under subsection (1)(c).
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
- 6 2020.
- 7 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 8 unless Senate Bill No. 1218
- 9 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
