HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION L

April 19, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Kelly, Garcia, Hornberger and Glenn and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 2 of article VIII, to allow limited financial support for children with special needs to attend any school of their choice, including nonpublic schools.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to allow limited financial support for children with special needs to attend any school of their choice, including nonpublic schools, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

1 ARTICLE VIII

- 1 Sec. 2. The legislature shall maintain and support a system of
- 2 free public elementary and secondary schools as defined by law.
- 3 Every school district shall provide for the education of its pupils
- 4 without discrimination as to religion, creed, race, color or
- 5 national origin.
- 6 No EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS PARAGRAPH, NO public monies or
- 7 property shall be appropriated or paid or any public credit
- 8 utilized, by the legislature or any other political subdivision or
- 9 agency of the state directly or indirectly to aid or maintain any
- 10 private, denominational or other nonpublic, pre-elementary,
- 11 elementary, or secondary school. No-EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS
- 12 PARAGRAPH, NO payment, credit, tax benefit, exemption or
- 13 deductions, tuition voucher, subsidy, grant or loan of public
- 14 monies or property shall be provided, directly or indirectly, to
- 15 support the attendance of any student or the employment of any
- 16 person at any such nonpublic school. or at any location or
- 17 institution where instruction is offered in whole or in part to
- 18 such nonpublic school students. The legislature may provide for the
- 19 transportation of students to and from any school. THE LEGISLATURE
- 20 SHALL PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS TO
- 21 ATTEND THE SCHOOL OF THEIR CHOICE, INCLUDING A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL, IF
- 22 THE AMOUNT OF THAT FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR A CHILD DOES NOT EXCEED
- 23 THE AMOUNT OF ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT THAT WOULD BE PROVIDED
- 24 TO A PUBLIC SCHOOL ON THE CHILD'S BEHALF DUE TO HIS OR HER SPECIAL
- 25 NEEDS IF THE CHILD WERE ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- 26 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
- 27 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
