AN ACT to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "An act to consolidate prior acts naming certain Michigan highways; to provide for the naming of certain highways; to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department; and to repeal acts and parts of acts and certain resolutions," (MCL 250.1001 to 250.2080) by adding section 10a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 10a. The portion of highway M-10 in Wayne County between highway I-94 and Grand River Avenue shall be known as the "Sergeant Collin Rose Memorial Highway".
