### **SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 118 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to create a Blue Star Family special registration plate and allow a member of a Blue Star Family to apply to the Secretary of State to be issued one. The plate would be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by a Blue Star Families insignia and would have the words "Blue Star Family" inscribed beneath the registration number.

An application for a Blue Star Family special registration plate would be on a form prescribed by the Secretary of State and would have to be accompanied by any proof required by the Secretary of State that the applicant was a *Blue Star Family member*. The applicant would have to pay a \$5 service fee in addition to the applicable vehicle registration tax.

**Blue Star Family member** would mean a person who is currently serving, or who has an **immediate family member** serving, in the United States Armed Forces or in forces incorporated as part of the United States Armed Forces.

*Immediate family member* would mean a parent, stepparent, adoptive parent, foster parent standing in loco parentis, child, stepchild, adopted child, sibling, half-sibling, spouse, or grandparent.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The bill would create a marginal one-time cost for the Department of State (DOS) and have no fiscal impact on local units of government. DOS would incur the cost of approximately \$45,000 related to the production of a new special registration plate. The costs of producing a new specialty plate are primarily due to the cost of computer programming. This cost could be supported with current ongoing appropriations.
