SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 963 would amend the Management and Budget Act to delay until 2021 the implementation of a provision requiring the legislature to pass and present to the governor general appropriation bills for the upcoming fiscal year by July 1.

The provision was added by 2019 PA 160 and currently provides a July 1, 2020, deadline for passing and presenting budget bills for the 2020-21 fiscal year.

The bill would instead make the deadline effective beginning July 1, 2021.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on state or local units of government.
