SUMMARY:

House Bill 5721 would amend the Insurance Code to require health insurance policy coverage of emergency and early refills.

The bill would provide that, until June 30, 2021, an insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, or renews in this state a health insurance policy that provides coverage for prescription drugs must do both of the following:

- Provide coverage for an emergency refill of up to a 60-day supply of any noncontrolled maintenance medication.
- Provide coverage for an early refill of any 30-day or 60-day prescription maintenance drug to allow for up to a 90-day supply, regardless of whether the pharmacy is mail order or in person.
