SUMMARY:

House Bill 6333 would amend 1893 PA 58, which provides a method for determining which member of the House of Representatives gets which seat in the House chamber, to provide for seats to be selected as determined by the House clerk.

Currently under the act, state representatives are allowed to choose their seats in an order determined by a combination of seniority and the drawing of lots.

The bill would instead provide for seats to be selected in a manner prescribed by the clerk of the House of Representatives.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on state or local government.
