

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4412

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 17766g.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 17766g. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
2 (4), a person shall not knowingly or willfully sell or trade a
3 finished drug product containing any quantity of dextromethorphan
4 to a minor.

5 (2) A person making a retail sale of a finished drug product
6 containing any quantity of dextromethorphan must require and obtain
7 proof of age from the purchaser before completing the sale, unless
8 from the purchaser's outward appearance the person making the sale
9 would reasonably presume the purchaser to be at least 25 years of



1 age.

2 (3) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (4), a minor
3 shall not purchase a finished drug product containing any quantity
4 of dextromethorphan.

5 (4) This section does not apply to a medication containing
6 dextromethorphan that is sold pursuant to a valid prescription.

7 (5) This section preempts any county, city, village, or
8 township ordinance or resolution regulating the sale, distribution,
9 receipt, or possession of dextromethorphan. A county, city,
10 village, or township shall not enact, adopt, maintain, or enforce
11 an ordinance or resolution that imposes conflicting, different, or
12 additional standards or requirements than those provided in this
13 section on the sale, distribution, receipt, or possession of
14 dextromethorphan.

15 (6) A person that violates subsection (1) is responsible for a
16 state civil infraction as provided under chapter 88 of the revised
17 judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.8801 to 600.8835, and
18 may be ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than \$100.00 for
19 each violation.

20 (7) An individual who violates subsection (3) is responsible
21 for a state civil infraction as provided under chapter 88 of the
22 revised judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.8801 to
23 600.8835, and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than
24 \$50.00 for each violation.

25 (8) As used in this section:

26 (a) "Dextromethorphan" means the dextrorotatory isomer of 3-
27 methoxy-N-methyl-morphinan and its salts.

28 (b) "Finished drug product" means that term as defined in 21
29 CFR 207.1.



1 (c) "Proof of age" means a valid government-issued photo
2 identification that includes the purchaser's name and date of
3 birth, including, but not limited to, a military identification
4 card, passport, or driver license.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
6 2020.
