GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. In accordance with section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state



resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending
September 30, 2020 is \$28,699,800.00. State appropriations paid to
local units of government are \$17,762,900.00 as follows:

Sec. 202. The appropriations authorized under this act are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

MICHIGAN NATURAL RESOURCES TRUST FUND

Sec. 301. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter into agreements with local units of government to administer the grants identified in part 1. Among other provisions, the agreements must require that grant recipients dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired or developed; to replace lands converted from or lost to public outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels acquired that are larger than 5 acres, to provide this state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient.

(2) The agreements under subsection (1) must also provide that the full payments of grants be made only after proof of acquisition, or proof of completion of the development project, is submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by the department of natural resources.

Sec. 302. The appropriations in part 1 for capital outlay shall be carried forward at the end of the fiscal year consistent

with the provisions of section 248 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1248.

Sec. 303. (1) The state share of the following capital outlay appropriation authorized in 2018 PA 165 for a Michigan natural resources trust fund project that has since been withdrawn by the grantee is reduced up to the amount indicated and the money lapsed for the purpose of redirecting resources to Michigan natural resources trust fund projects appropriated in part 1:
