A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.297), as amended by 2015 PA 72.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) The secretary of state may provide a commercial
- 2 look-up service of records maintained under this act. For each





- 1 individual record looked up, the secretary of state shall charge a
- 2 fee specified annually by the legislature, or if the legislature
- 3 does not specify a fee, a market-based price established by the
- 4 secretary of state. The secretary of state shall process a
- 5 commercial look-up request only if the request is in a form or
- 6 format as prescribed by the secretary of state. Fees_Until October
- 7 1, 2023, fees collected under this subsection on and after October
- 8 1, 2005 through October 1, 2019 shall must be credited to the
- 9 transportation administration collection fund created in section
- 10 810b of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.810b.
- 11 (2) The secretary of state shall establish and maintain a
- 12 computerized central file of the information contained on
- 13 application forms received under this act. The computerized central
- 14 file shall must be interfaced with the law enforcement information
- 15 network as provided in the C.J.I.S. policy council act, 1974 PA
- 16 163, MCL 28.211 to 28.215.
- 17 (3) Except as provided in section 10(2), the secretary of
- 18 state shall not provide an entire computerized central file or
- 19 other file of records maintained under this act to a
- 20 nongovernmental person or entity, unless the purchaser pays the
- 21 prescribed fee for each individual record contained within the
- 22 computerized file.
