

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5003

September 19, 2019, Introduced by Reps. A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled  
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"  
by amending section 43532 (MCL 324.43532), as amended by 2016 PA  
463.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           Sec. 43532. (1) An all-species fishing license entitles the  
2           licensee to take and possess all aquatic species as prescribed by  
3           law.

4           (2) An individual 17 years of age or older shall not take or



1 possess an aquatic species, except aquatic insects, in the waters  
2 over which this state has jurisdiction without ~~a~~**an all-species**  
3 **fishing** license. ~~The~~**Except as otherwise provided in this**  
4 **subsection, the** fee for a resident all-species fishing license is  
5 \$25.00. ~~The~~**Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the**  
6 fee for a nonresident all-species fishing license is \$75.00. **An**  
7 **individual under 17 years of age may take and possess aquatic**  
8 **species in the waters over which this state has jurisdiction**  
9 **without an all-species fishing license. However, an individual**  
10 **under 17 years of age may obtain an all-species fishing license.**  
11 **The fee for a resident or nonresident who is under 17 years of age**  
12 **for an all-species fishing license is \$2.00.**

13 (3) ~~Not later than March 1, 2018, the~~**The** department shall  
14 develop an electronic license that allows an individual to display  
15 an electronic copy of his or her all-species fishing license using  
16 an electronic device.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
18 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5002 (request no.  
19 03750'19) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
