## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5344

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 609c (MCL 436.1609c), as added by 2017 PA 130.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 609c. (1) A manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided under section 203(19)—203a or a wholesaler may refund to a retailer the amount the retailer paid for beer or wine, as applicable, or a manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided under section 203(19)—203a or a wholesaler may replace that beer or wine for any of the following reasons:
  - (a) The beer or wine is outdated.
  - (b) The beer or wine is defective.
- 9 (c) An error in the beer or wine delivered.

- 1 (d) The beer or wine may no longer be lawfully sold.
- 2 (e) The termination of the retailer's business.
- 3 (f) The formula, proof, label, or container of the beer or4 wine is changed.
- 5 (g) The beer or wine is discontinued.
- 6 (h) The retailer is only open a portion of the year and the7 beer or wine is likely to spoil during the off-season.
- 8 (2) If beer is within 30 days of its out-of-date code, a
  9 manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided under
  10 section 203(19) 203a or a wholesaler may refund to a retailer the
  11 amount the retailer paid for the beer.
- 12 (3) A manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided
  13 under section 203(19)—203a or a wholesaler may only issue a refund
  14 or replacement under this section for beer or wine that the
  15 manufacturer or wholesaler sold to the retailer.
