SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5735

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

by amending section 6 (MCL 28.306), as amended by 2020 PA 243.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6. (1) An application for an original enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card must be accompanied by payment of a fee of not more than \$50.00.
- 4 (2) The renewal fee for an enhanced driver license or enhanced 5 official state personal identification card renewed under this act
- 6 must be not more than \$50.00. However, if an enhanced driver
- 7 license or enhanced official state personal identification card is
- 8 expired at the time of renewal, the fee must be the same as the fee

- 1 provided under subsection (1). If the secretary of state receives
- 2 an application to renew an enhanced driver license or enhanced
- 3 official state personal identification card that expires on or
- 4 after March 1, 2020 before December 11, 2020, March 31, 2021, the
- 5 secretary of state shall process the application as a renewal of an
- 6 existing enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 7 personal identification card.
- **8** (3) Money from fees collected under subsections (1) and (2)
- 9 must be deposited into the enhanced driver license and enhanced
- 10 official state personal identification card fund created in section
- 11 7 after distribution as follows:
- 12 (a) The secretary of state shall refund to each county or
- 13 municipality acting as an examining officer or examining bureau
- 14 \$2.50 for each applicant examined for an original enhanced driver
- 15 license, if the application is not denied and the money refunded is
- 16 paid to the county or local treasurer and is appropriated to the
- 17 county, municipality, or officer or bureau receiving the money for
- 18 the purpose of carrying out this act.
- 19 (b) The state treasurer shall deposit the sum of \$4.00 to the
- 20 traffic law enforcement and safety fund created in section 819a of
- 21 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.819a, for each
- 22 person examined for an original or renewal enhanced driver license.
- (c) Four dollars and 50 cents of an original enhanced driver
- 24 license and \$6.00 of a renewal enhanced driver license must be
- 25 appropriated to the transportation economic development fund
- 26 established in section 2 of 1987 PA 231, MCL 247.902, and must not
- 27 be appropriated for any other purpose in any act making
- 28 appropriations of state funds.
- 29 (d) The money remaining after distributions are made under

- 1 subdivisions (a) through (c) must remain in the enhanced driver
- 2 license and enhanced official state personal identification card
- 3 fund created under section 7.
- 4 (4) The secretary of state may assess a fee for issuing a
- 5 duplicate or corrected enhanced driver license or enhanced official
- 6 state personal identification card. A fee assessed under this
- 7 subsection must not exceed the following amounts:
- 8 (a) Thirty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is an
- 9 operator's license.
- (b) Forty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is a
- 11 chauffeur's license.
- 12 (c) Thirty dollars for an enhanced official state personal
- 13 identification card.
- 14 (5) A fee must not be charged under subsection (4) for a
- 15 change of address, to correct a departmental error, or to add or
- 16 remove a heart insignia described in section 310 of the Michigan
- 17 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310.
- 18 (6) Fees collected under subsection (4) must be deposited to
- 19 the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal
- 20 identification card fund created under section 7.
- 21 (7) A fee paid under this section is nonrefundable, except for
- 22 administrative error.
- 23 (8) The secretary of state shall not assess a late renewal fee
- 24 for an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 25 identification card that expires on or after March 1, 2020 and is
- 26 renewed before December 11, 2020.March 31, 2021.
