

SENATE BILL NO. 193

March 12, 2019, Introduced by Senators VICTORY, BARRETT and JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 384, entitled "Driver education provider and instructor act," by amending section 39 (MCL 256.659), as amended by 2010 PA 16.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 39. A segment 2 curriculum course provided under this act
2 ~~shall~~**must** meet all of the following requirements:

3 (a) Be offered only to a student who has done all of the
4 following:

5 (i) Successfully completed a segment 1 curriculum driver

1 education course.

2 (ii) Held a valid level 1 graduated driver license for not less
3 than 3 continuous months.

4 (iii) Acquired 30 or more hours driving experience on a level 1
5 graduated driver license that includes, **except as otherwise**
6 **provided in this subparagraph**, not less than 2 hours of night
7 driving with a licensed parent or legal guardian, or with the
8 permission of a parent or legal guardian, with any licensed driver
9 who is 21 years of age or older. **The nighttime hours requirement**
10 **does not apply to a person who has been issued a graduated driver**
11 **license that permits daylight driving only as provided in R 257.3**
12 **of the Michigan Administrative Code.**

13 (b) Contain 6 or more hours of classroom instruction that is
14 scheduled so the student receives not more than 2 hours of
15 classroom instruction per day.

16 (c) Provide instruction explaining the right to make an
17 anatomical gift in the event of death under part 101 of the public
18 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10123. Instructional
19 materials to effectuate this subdivision ~~shall~~**must** be developed in
20 cooperation with the federally designated organ procurement
21 organization for this state and ~~shall~~**must** include information on
22 how to join the state organ, tissue, and eye donor registry. The
23 following apply to instruction provided under this subdivision:

24 (i) If instruction material is provided at no cost to the
25 driver education provider in an electronic medium and the provider
26 uses a compatible type of electronic medium in providing
27 instruction under this section, the provider shall show the
28 instruction material to its students.

29 (ii) If instruction material is provided at no cost to the

1 driver education provider in the form of a brochure or other
2 written material, the provider shall provide the material to its
3 students.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No. 192 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into
6 law.
