SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 94

A bill to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled "Mental health code,"

by amending section 1060a (MCL 330.2060a), as added by 2012 PA 540.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1060a. (1) "Competency evaluation" means a court-ordered examination of a juvenile directed to developing information relevant to a determination of his or her competency to proceed at a particular stage of a court proceeding involving a juvenile who is the subject of a delinquency petition.
 - (2) "Competency hearing" means a hearing to determine whether a juvenile is competent to proceed.
- 8 (3) "Incompetent to proceed" means that a juvenile, based on9 age-appropriate norms, lacks a reasonable degree of rational and

- factual understanding of the proceeding or is unable to do 1 or
 more of the following:
- 3 (a) Consult with and assist his or her attorney in preparing4 his or her defense in a meaningful manner.
 - (b) Sufficiently understand the charges against him or her.
- (4) "Juvenile" means a person who is less than 17-18 years of
 age who is the subject of a delinquency petition.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October1, 2021.
