- Sec. 7b. A foster care student is eligible for a fostering
 futures scholarship if all of the following apply:
- 3 (a) Due to child abuse or child neglect, the foster care
- 4 student was in foster care after his or her thirteenth birthday.

- 1 (b) The foster care student is attending an either of the
 2 following:
- 3 (i) An institution of higher education in this state as4 determined by the department.
- (ii) A trade school or technical school in this state. As used 5 6 in this subparagraph, "trade school" or "technical school" means a 7 postsecondary institution that is designed to give a student the 8 technical skills to prepare him or her for a specific occupation 9 which institution qualifies as an eligible education institution as 10 that term is defined in section 529(e)(5) of the internal revenue 11 code, 26 USC 529, and the institution's programs lead to positive 12 employment and earnings outcomes for its graduates, as determined
- 14 (c) The foster care student has an unmet financial education
 15 need.
