SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 691

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending section 1108 (MCL 339.1108), as amended by 2014 PA 136.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1108. (1) The department shall issue a license to
 practice as a barber to an individual who fulfills all of the
 following requirements:
- 4 (a) Is not less than 17 years of age.
- 5 (b) Is of good moral character.
- $\bf 6$ (c) Demonstrates satisfactory completion of $\bf not$ **either of the**
- 7 following:
- 8 (i) Not less than a 1,800-hour course of study at a licensed9 barber college.





- (ii) Subject to subsection (4), a barber apprenticeship program.
- 3 (d) Passes an examination approved by the board and the4 department.
- (e) Has completed the tenth grade of school or has anequivalent education as determined by the department.
- 7 (2) The department shall issue a license as a barber to an individual who has held a license as a barber in another state, 8 9 jurisdiction, or country for 1 out of the 3 years immediately 10 preceding the date of application if the requirements for licensure in the other state, jurisdiction, or country are substantially 11 12 equivalent to the requirements of subsection (1), as determined by 13 the department. However, the department may deny or limit a license 14 described in this subsection if the applicant has been disciplined, 15 or disciplinary action is pending, in another state, jurisdiction, 16 or country.
 - (3) For the purposes of fulfilling the requirement of subsection (1)(c), (1)(c)(i), an individual whose instruction as a barber was received in another state, jurisdiction, or country may substitute experience as a barber or barber apprentice for instruction in the ratio of 3 months of experience for 100 hours of instruction. However, if his or her the individual's experience as a barber or barber apprentice was acquired in a country that the department considers a country from which records are not generally available, both of the following apply to the substitution of experience for instruction under this subsection:
 - (a) He or she The individual may not substitute experience for instruction under this subsection unless he or she provides a signed and notarized attestation detailing his or her experience,

- including his or her place of employment or apprenticeship, to the
 department.
- 3 (b) He or she The individual may not substitute experience for
 4 any of the hours of instruction concerning safety and sanitation,
 5 or concerning laws, rules, and regulations, required by the
 6 department by rules promulgated under this article.
 - (4) A barber apprenticeship program does not satisfy the requirements of subsection (1)(c)(ii) unless the owner of the barber college or barbershop that conducts the apprenticeship program ensures that the apprenticeship program meets all of the following requirements:
- 12 (a) A student or apprentice is not required to be in 13 attendance for more than 40 hours per week.
- (b) A daily record of the attendance of each student or apprentice is maintained and a copy of the record is sent to the department monthly.
- 17 (c) A grading system for students or apprentices is 18 established.
- 19 (d) A student or apprentice is required to pass an examination 20 before the owner of the barber college or barbershop certifies to 21 the department that he or she has completed training.
 - (e) Before the barber college begins training a student, or the barbershop accepts an apprentice, the owner of the barber college or barbershop obtains proof that the student or apprentice has a high school education, or the equivalent of a high school education. This subdivision does not apply to a student who is enrolling in a program offered as a part of the regular curriculum of a public school and approved by the state board of education.
 - (f) Before the barber college begins training a student, or

- 1 the barbershop accepts an apprentice, the owner of the barber
- 2 college or barbershop submits an application to the department on
- 3 behalf of the student or apprentice. The owner of the barber
- 4 college or barbershop shall retain a copy of the proof of education
- 5 described in subdivision (e), if applicable, and the application
- 6 described in this subdivision in the records of the barber college
- 7 or barbershop until the student or apprentice applies for
- 8 examination to obtain a license.
- 9 (5) The owner of a barbershop that conducts an apprenticeship 10 program shall not charge a fee for the teaching of barber services 11 to apprentices on the premises. The owner of a barbershop where 1 12 apprentice has been successfully trained may allow the training of 13 additional apprentices at the establishment, except that not more 14 than 2 apprentices may be trained at the same time.
- 15 (6) If the location of a barbershop where an apprenticeship
 16 program is conducted changes, the owner of the barbershop may
 17 continue the apprenticeship program at the new location if a new
 18 license is issued under section 1111, and an apprentice who was
 19 receiving training at the original location may continue to receive
 20 training at the new location.
