HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 878

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

by amending sections 4 and 6 (MCL 28.304 and 28.306), section 4 as amended by 2018 PA 47 and section 6 as amended by 2009 PA 211.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced

2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification

card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her

4 full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of

5 birth, social security Social Security number, residence address,

6 and a photographic identity document. An applicant may choose to

7 apply for a standard driver license or standard official state



- personal identification card or an enhanced driver license or
 enhanced official state personal identification card.
- 9 (3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state 10 personal identification card may include radio frequency 11 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned number , which shall that must be encrypted if agreed to by the 12 United States Department of Homeland Security, and does not include 13 14 biometric data. The secretary of state shall ensure that the radio 15 frequency identification technology is secure from unauthorized 16 data access and includes reasonable security measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal information. An 17 18 applicant must sign a declaration acknowledging his or her understanding of the radio frequency identification technology 19 20 before he or she is issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced 21 official state personal identification card.
 - (4) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card that expires on or after March 1, 2020 is considered valid until September 30, 2020.
 - (5) (4)—The requirements of this act are in addition to the requirements otherwise imposed on individuals who apply for a standard driver license or standard official state personal identification card.
 - (6) (5)—The holder of an enhanced driver license issued under

- 3 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction,
- 4 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition
- 5 of points to a driving record; until October 1, 2018, the
- 6 assessment of a driver responsibility fee; the assessment of a
- 7 civil fine or criminal penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil
- 8 infraction determination; the imposition of probationary terms and

- 10 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.
- 11 Sec. 6. (1) An application for an original enhanced driver
- 12 license or enhanced official state personal identification card
- 13 shall must be accompanied by payment of a fee of not more than
- **14** \$50.00.
- 15 (2) The renewal fee for an enhanced driver license or enhanced
- 16 official state personal identification card renewed under this act
- 17 shall must be not more than \$50.00. However, if an enhanced driver
- 18 license or enhanced official state personal identification card is
- 19 expired at the time of renewal, the fee shall must be the same as
- 20 the fee provided under subsection (1). If the secretary of state
- 21 receives an application to renew an enhanced driver license or
- 22 enhanced official state personal identification card that expires
- 23 on or after March 1, 2020 before September 30, 2020, the secretary
- 24 of state shall process the application as a renewal of an existing
- 25 enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 26 identification card.
- 27 (3) Money from fees collected under subsections (1) and (2)
- 28 shall must be deposited into the enhanced driver license and
- 29 enhanced official state personal identification card fund created

1 in section 7 after distribution as follows:

- 2 (a) The secretary of state shall refund to each county or
 3 municipality acting as an examining officer or examining bureau
 4 \$2.50 for each applicant examined for an original enhanced driver
 5 license, if the application is not denied and the money refunded is
 6 paid to the county or local treasurer and is appropriated to the
 7 county, municipality, or officer or bureau receiving the money for
 8 the purpose of carrying out this act.
 - (b) The state treasurer shall deposit the sum of \$4.00 to the traffic law enforcement and safety fund created in section 819a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.819a, for each person examined for an original or renewal enhanced driver license.
 - (c) Four dollars and 50 cents of an original enhanced driver license and \$6.00 of a renewal enhanced driver license shall must be appropriated to the transportation economic development fund established in section 2 of 1987 PA 231, MCL 247.902, and shall must not be appropriated for any other purpose in any act making appropriations of state funds.
 - (d) The money remaining after distributions are made under subdivisions (a) through (c) shall must remain in the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card fund created under section 7.
 - (4) The secretary of state may assess a fee for issuing a duplicate or corrected enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card. A fee assessed under this subsection shall must not exceed the following amounts:
 - (a) Thirty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is an operator's license.
 - (b) Forty dollars for an enhanced driver license that is a

- (c) Thirty dollars for an enhanced official state personalidentification card.
- 4 (5) A fee shall must not be charged under subsection (4) for a change of address, to correct a departmental error, or to add or remove a heart insignia described in section 310 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310.
 - (6) Fees collected under subsection (4) shall must be deposited to the enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card fund created under section 7.
 - (7) A fee paid under this section is nonrefundable, except for administrative error.
 - (8) The secretary of state shall not assess a late renewal fee for an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal identification card that expires on or after March 1, 2020 and is renewed before September 30, 2020.
