## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 783

A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled "Youth tobacco act,"

(MCL 722.641 to 722.645) by adding section 1a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1a. (1) A person who sells vapor products at retail shall not do any of the following:
  - (a) Advertise a vapor product in a manner that causes a minor to believe that health benefits may be derived from the use of the vapor product, unless the vapor product is approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration.
- 7 (b) Promote a vapor product by comparing the health effects 8 that arise from the use of vapor products with the health effects 9 that arise from the use of tobacco products.

- 1 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is responsible for a 2 state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (a) For a first offense, not more than \$500.00 in a calendar
- 5 year.
- 6 (b) For a second offense, not more than \$1,000.00 in a
- 7 calendar year.
- 8 (c) For a third or subsequent offense, not more than \$2,500.00
- 9 in a calendar year.
- 10 (3) Subject to the restrictions in this section, a person may
- 11 sell a vapor product of any flavor to an individual who is at least
- 12 21 years of age.
- 13 (4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the
- 14 contrary, the presence of the following flavors alone, without
- 15 more, is not considered to be appealing to minors:
- 16 (a) Tobacco.
- 17 (b) Menthol.
- 18 (c) Fruit or a combination of common fruits.
