## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4135**

February 06, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Calley, LaGrand, Rendon, Filler, Wozniak, Guerra, Elder, Hauck, Brann and Love and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure,"

by amending section 11 of chapter II (MCL 762.11), as amended by 2015 PA 31.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER II

Sec. 11. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), if

an individual pleads guilty to a criminal offense, committed on or

after the individual's seventeenth eighteenth birthday but before

- 1 his or her twenty-fourth birthday, the court of record having
- 2 jurisdiction of the criminal offense may, without entering a
- 3 judgment of conviction and with the consent of that individual,
- 4 consider and assign that individual to the status of youthful
- 5 trainee. If the offense was committed on or after the individual's
- 6 twenty-first birthday but before his or her twenty-fourth birthday,
- 7 the individual shall must not be assigned to youthful trainee
- 8 status without the consent of the prosecuting attorney.
- 9 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:
- 10 (a) A felony for which the maximum penalty is imprisonment for
  11 life.
- 12 (b) A major controlled substance offense.
- 13 (c) A traffic offense.
- 14 (d) A violation, attempted violation, or conspiracy to violate
- 15 section 520b, 520c, 520d, or 520e of the Michigan penal code, 1931
- 16 PA 328, MCL 750.520b, 750.520c, 750.520d, and 750.520e, other than
- 17 section 520d(1)(a) or 520e(1)(a) of the Michigan penal code, 1931
- 18 PA 328, MCL 750.520d and 750.520e.
- 19 (e) A violation, attempted violation, or conspiracy to violate
- 20 section 520g of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520g,
- 21 with the intent to commit a violation of section 520b, 520c, 520d,
- 22 or 520e of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520b,
- 23 750.520c, 750.520d, and 750.520e, other than section 520d(1)(a) or
- 24 520e(1)(a) of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520d
- **25** and 750.520e.
- 26 (3) The court shall not assign an individual to the status of
- 27 youthful trainee if any of the following apply:
- 28 (a) The individual was previously convicted of or adjudicated
- 29 for a listed offense for which registration is required under the

- 1 sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 to 28.736.
- 2 (b) If the individual is charged with a listed offense for
- 3 which registration is required under the sex offenders registration
- 4 act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 to 28.736, the individual fails to
- 5 carry the burden of proving by clear and convincing evidence that
- 6 he or she is not likely to engage in further listed offenses.
- 7 (c) The court determines that the offense involved any of the
- 8 following:
- 9 (i) A factor set forth in section 520b(1) (a) to (h) of the
- 10 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520b.
- 11 (ii) A factor set forth in section 520c(1) (a) to (l) of the
- 12 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520c.
- 13 (iii) A factor set forth in section 520d(1) (b) to  $\frac{(e)}{(e)}$  of the
- 14 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520d.
- 15 (iv) A factor set forth in section 520e(1)(b) to  $\frac{(f)}{(f)}$  of the
- 16 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520e.
- 17 (4) If the court assigns an individual to the status of
- 18 youthful trainee under this section, the court may require the
- 19 individual to maintain employment or to attend a high school, high
- 20 school equivalency program, community college, college, university,
- 21 or trade school. If the individual is not employed or attending a
- 22 high school, community college, college, university, or trade
- 23 school, the individual may be required to actively seek employment
- 24 or entry into a high school, high school equivalency program,
- 25 community college, college, university, or trade school.
- 26 (5) If the offense for which the individual is assigned to the
- 27 status of youthful trainee status was committed on or after the
- 28 individual's twenty-first birthday, the individual may, in addition
- 29 to the other requirements of this section, be subject to electronic

- monitoring during his or her probationary term as provided undersection 3 of chapter XI.
- **3** (6) As used in this section:
- 4 (a) "Listed offense" means that term as defined in section 2 5 of the sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.722.
- 6 (b) "Traffic offense" means a violation of the Michigan
- 7 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or a violation of
- 8 a local ordinance substantially corresponding to that act, that
- 9 involves the operation of a vehicle and, at the time of the
- 10 violation, is a felony or a misdemeanor.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
- **12** 1, 2019.
