A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled "The state school aid act of 1979,"

- 5 be adjusted for changes in caseload and related costs, federal fund
- 6 match rates, economic factors, and available revenue. These
- 7 adjustments will be determined after the January 2019-2020
- 8 consensus revenue estimating conference.
