A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 479d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 479d. (1) A person who commits or attempts to commit a
- 2 violent felony in which the victim is targeted because he or she
- 3 is, or is perceived to be, a law enforcement officer, reserve





- 1 officer, or corrections officer is quilty of a felony punishable by
- 2 imprisonment for not more than 2 years, to be served consecutively
- 3 to any term of imprisonment imposed for the underlying felony or
- 4 attempted felony.

- 11 (c) "Reserve officer" means an individual authorized on a

- 16 and the enforcement of the general criminal laws of this state.
