A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 606. (1) The circuit court has jurisdiction to hear and determine a specified juvenile violation if committed by a juvenile 14 years of age or older and less than 17-18 years of age.
- 4 (2) As used in this section, "specified juvenile violation"5 means any of the following:
- 6 (a) A violation of section 72, 83, 86, 89, 91, 316, 317, 349,

- 14 (h) Any lesser included offense of a violation described in
- 15 subdivisions (a) to (g) if the individual is charged with a
- 16 violation described in subdivisions (a) to (g).
- 17 (i) Any other violation arising out of the same transaction as
- 18 a violation described in subdivisions (a) to (g) if the individual
- 19 is charged with a violation described in subdivisions (a) to (q).
