A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act,"

(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4ff.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4ff. Beginning 90 days after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section through December 31, 2021, a sale of firearm safety devices is exempt from the tax under this act. Upon the retail sale or transfer of a firearm, the seller shall provide a written notice to the purchaser and shall post in a conspicuous manner at all points of sale on the premises where

- 4 As used in this section, "firearm safety devices" means safes, lock

- 9 aid fund created in section 11 of article IX of the state
