THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 13. A local workforce development board shall do all of
 the following in cooperation with the chief elected officials in
 the Michigan works area:
- 4 (a) Develop and submit to the governor a plan for coordinating5 local workforce development services for employers and job seekers

- (f) Oversee the operation of the one-stop delivery of services through the Michigan works one-stop service center system.

 with the department for evaluating and improving the Michigan works
 one-stop service center system.
- (h) Coordinate workforce development activities with other
 economic development activities and strategies in the Michigan
 works area.
- (i) Promote private sector employer participation in theMichigan works one-stop service center system.
- 20 (j) Make available connecting, brokering, and coaching
 21 activities through intermediaries to help meet employer hiring

 - (k) Establish a peer-to-peer apprenticeship mentoring program for women, minorities, and persons with disabilities to provide mentoring and support services to these groups and establish a network of peers involved in apprenticeship groups among these groups. The program must analyze which groups of people are under-represented in industries and form employee resource groups for apprentices involved in those industries.
