A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 18830.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 18830. (1) A veterinarian shall not perform a devocalization procedure on an animal unless the veterinarian determines that the procedure is for a therapeutic purpose.
- 4 (2) If a veterinarian determines that a devocalization 5 procedure is for a therapeutic purpose, the veterinarian shall

- 1 prepare and file with the board a written statement that states the
- 2 purpose for performing the procedure and provides the name and
- 3 address of the animal's owner. The veterinarian shall also provide
- 4 a copy of the statement to the animal's owner.
 - (3) As used in this section:
- 6 (a) "Devocalization" means a procedure on the larynx or vocal
- 7 cords of an animal that causes the reduction or elimination of
- 8 vocal sounds produced by that animal.
- 9 (b) "Therapeutic purpose" means a purpose that is medically
- 10 necessary to treat or relieve an illness, disease, or injury or to
- 11 correct a congenital abnormality that is causing or may cause the
- 12 animal physical pain or harm.

- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 14 after the date it is enacted into law.
