HOUSE BILL NO. 4695

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Rep. Brann and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 497, entitled "Construction lien act,"

by amending section 114 (MCL 570.1114), as amended by 2016 PA 415.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 114. (1) A contractor does not have a right to a 2 construction lien on the interest of an owner or lessee in a
- 3 residential structure unless the contractor has provided an
- 4 improvement to the residential structure under a written contract





- 1 between the owner or lessee and the contractor and any amendments
- 2 or additions to the contract are also in writing. The contract
- 3 required under this section shall must contain a statement, in type
- 4 no smaller than that of the body of the contract, stating all of
- 5 the following:
- 6 (a) That a residential builder or a residential maintenance
- 7 and alteration contractor is required to be licensed under article
- 8 24 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2401 to 339.2412.
- 9 That an electrician is required to be licensed under article 7 of
- 10 the skilled trades regulation act, 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.5701 to
- 11 339.5739. That a plumbing contractor is required to be licensed
- 12 under article 11 of the skilled trades regulation act, 2016 PA 407,
- 13 MCL 339.6101 to 339.6133. That a mechanical contractor is required
- 14 to be licensed under article 8 of the skilled trades regulation
- 15 act, 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.5801 to 339.5819.
- 16 (b) If the contractor is required to be licensed to provide
- 17 the contracted improvement, that the contractor is licensed and the
- 18 contractor's license number.
- 19 (2) A contractor who is required to be licensed, as described
- 20 in this section, shall display the contractor's license and, if the
- 21 contractor is an individual, the contractor's personal
- 22 identification, consisting of an operator's license, chauffeur's
- 23 license, or personal identification card issued by the department
- 24 of state, when recording a claim of lien under section 111. If the
- 25 claim of lien is not presented in person, the contractor shall
- 26 attach to the claim of lien copies of the contractor's license and
- 27 personal identification.
- 28 (3) If a contractor is required to be licensed, as described
- 29 in this section, a register of deeds shall not accept a claim of



- 1 lien to be recorded from the contractor unless the contractor
- 2 displays the contractor's license and personal identification, or
- 3 attaches copies of the contractor's license and personal
- 4 identification to the claim of lien, as required by subsection (2).
- 5 (4) A contractor who violates this section is guilty of a
- 6 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or
- 7 a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 9 after the date it is enacted into law.
