## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4697**

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Rep. Coleman and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 235, entitled "Public threat alert system act,"

by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 28.672 and 28.673).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2. As used in this act, "public threat" means a clear,
   present, persistent, ongoing, and random threat to public safety. A
- 3 public threat includes, but is not limited to, an act of terrorism,
- 4 an unresolved mass shooting, or an unresolved mass shooting spree,
- 5 or any catastrophic incident as that term is defined under 6 USC
- 6 311.





- Sec. 3. (1) The department of state police shall establish and
   maintain the public threat alert system plan.
- 3 (2) The department of state police shall design the public
- 4 threat alert system plan shall be designed to rapidly disseminate
- 5 useful information in a predetermined manner to radio and
- 6 television stations within in this state and to wireless devices
- 7 through the existing wireless emergency alert system operated under
- 8 federal law.
- 9 (3) The public threat alert system plan shall must be
  10 activated only in accordance with the policies established by the
- 11 department of state police.
- 12 (4) The public threat alert system plan must require that a
- 13 qualified interpreter, as that term is defined in section 2 of the
- 14 deaf persons' interpreters act, 1982 PA 204, MCL 393.502, is
- 15 included in any televised broadcast of a developing or ongoing
- 16 public threat.
