

HOUSE BILL NO. 4701

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Reps. A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406u.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3406u. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery,
2 or renews in this state a health insurance policy that provides
3 coverage for prescription insulin shall cap the total amount that
4 an insured is required to pay for prescription insulin at an amount
5 not to exceed \$100.00 per 30-day supply of insulin, regardless of



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1 the amount or type of insulin needed to fill the insured's
2 prescription.

3 (2) This section does not prevent an insurer described in
4 subsection (1) from reducing the insured's cost sharing by an
5 amount greater than \$100.00.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act applies to health
7 insurance policies delivered, executed, issued, amended, adjusted,
8 or renewed in this state, or outside of this state if covering
9 residents of this state, beginning 90 days after the date this
10 amendatory act is enacted into law.
