THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) Before certifying an individual for licensure as a
- 2 foster parent, a child placing agency shall must conduct an
- 3 orientation designed to ensure the individual's understanding of
- 4 the purposes of foster care, including the temporary nature of

- 1 foster care and the ultimate goal of returning the child to his or
- 2 her permanent family or preparing the child for adoption.
- 3 (2) Before placing a child with foster parents, a child
 4 placing agency shall must provide the foster parents with written
 5 information including all of the following:
 - (a) Any history of abuse or neglect of the child.
- 7 (b) All known emotional and psychological problems of the 8 child.
- 9 (c) All behavior problems of the child that might present any10 risk to the foster family.
- (d) Any other information necessary to enable the foster
 family to provide a stable, safe, and healthy environment for the
 foster child and for other members of the foster family.
- 14 (3) The child placing agency shall explain to the foster15 parents that the information provided under subsection (2) about16 the child and the child's family is confidential.
- 17 (4) After a child placing agency has certified an individual 18 for licensure as a foster parent, the department shall not deny a 19 license or otherwise discriminate against a foster parent, or 20 potential foster parent, because of the immunization status of the 21 foster parent or his or her birth or adopted children.
