

HOUSE BILL NO. 4714

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Slagh, Brixie, Frederick, Green, Eisen and LaGrand and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Municipal Finance.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 206 (MCL 168.206).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 206. The office of county clerk, county treasurer,
2 register of deeds, prosecuting attorney, sheriff, drain
3 commissioner, surveyor, or coroner in any county in this state
4 ~~shall become~~ **becomes** vacant upon the happening of any of the
5 following events:

6 (a) Death of the incumbent. ~~his~~



1 **(b) The incumbent's** resignation. ~~; his~~

2 **(c) The incumbent's** removal from office for cause. ~~; his~~

3 **(d) The incumbent's** ceasing to be a resident of the county in
4 which his **or her** office is located. ~~; his~~

5 **(e) The incumbent's** conviction of an infamous crime or an
6 offense involving the violation of his **or her** oath of office. ~~; the~~

7 **(f) The** decision of a competent tribunal declaring his **or her**
8 election or appointment void. ~~; his~~

9 **(g) The incumbent's** refusal or neglect to take and subscribe
10 to the constitutional oath of office and deposit the same in the
11 manner and within the time prescribed by law. ~~; or his refusal or~~
12 ~~neglect to give bond in the amount and manner and within the time~~
13 ~~prescribed by law.~~
