THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVI
 Sec. 5. A law enforcement agency shall not adopt or implement

sec. 5. A law enforcement agency shall not adopt or implement a policy that permits a peace officer to stop and search a person unless that policy conforms to the following:

(a) The stop is for investigative purposes and the peace

- 1 officer has reasonable suspicion to believe the person has been,
- 2 is, or is about to be engaged in criminal activity.
- 3 (b) The search is of a person stopped for investigative
- 4 purposes and the peace officer has reasonable suspicion to believe

- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
