## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4739**

June 19, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Berman, Eisen and Garza and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1263a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1263a. (1) Not later than August 15, 2020, and not later than August 15 of each subsequent year, the department of health and human services shall inspect each school building operated by a public or nonpublic school for health and safety violations.
  - (2) Not later than March 1, 2020, the department of health and

- 4 (3) Not later than 14 days after an inspection under
- 5 subsection (1), the department of health and human services shall
- 6 provide notice of any health and safety violation in a school
- 7 building operated by a public or nonpublic school to the governing
- 8 body of the school. A notice under this subsection must include any
- 9 modifications or remedial measures required or recommended by the
- 10 department of health and human services.
- 11 (4) Not later than 14 days after receiving a notice under
- 12 subsection (3), the governing body that received the notice shall
- 13 submit proof of any remedial measures taken to correct the
- 14 violations described in the notice to the department of health and
- 15 human services, in a form and manner prescribed by the department
- 16 of health and human services.
- 17 (5) As used in this section, "school building" means either of
- 18 the following:
- 19 (a) A building used primarily to provide instruction to
- 20 pupils.
- 21 (b) A recreational or athletic structure or field intended to
- 22 be used by pupils.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
