## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4836**

August 28, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Farrington and Brann and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 270, entitled "Michigan strategic fund act,"

(MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094) by adding section 15.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 15. (1) The fund, in conjunction with the department of
- 2 licensing and regulatory affairs and the department of treasury,
- 3 shall investigate the feasibility of developing and operating a
- 4 virtual business road map created by a third party vendor that does
- 5 all the following:
  - (a) Through a question-and-answer format identifies possible

- 1 legal entities for the conduct of the applicant's business and
- 2 assists in applying for 1 or more legal entity designations with
- 3 this state.
- 4 (b) Assist users with state compliance issues, including sales
- 5 tax, use tax, unemployment compensation, and workers' compensation
- 6 issues, and assists the applicant in identifying and applying for
- 7 the appropriate licenses, certificates, and other state government
- 8 authorizations.
- 9 (c) Links to other business startup resources in state, local,
- 10 and federal government to assist the virtual business road map
- 11 user.
- 12 (2) The fund shall contract with 1 or more third party vendors
- 13 to conduct the investigation into the feasibility of developing and
- 14 operating the virtual business road map described in subsection
- 15 (1). The fund shall select 1 or more third party vendors that are
- 16 able to use the most appropriate technology to make the virtual
- 17 business roadmap user-friendly.
- 18 (3) The fund shall report its findings to the governor and
- 19 each house of the legislature not later than October 1, 2020.
