A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 5506f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5506f. The department shall not issue a permit under this
- 2 part if the permitted emissions present a serious threat to public
- 3 health for residents living within 5 miles of the source of the
- 4 emissions. In making this determination, the department shall do





- 1 both of the following:
- 2 (a) Use as a baseline the public health for residents living 3 within 5 miles of the source of the emissions.
- 4 (b) Consider all of the following socioeconomic factors
 5 related to residents living within 5 miles of the source of the
 6 emissions:
- 7 (i) Education background, as measured by the highest year of 8 school completed or other similar categorical variable.
 - (ii) Income level.

- 10 (iii) Health behavioral criteria, such as adult obesity rates
 11 and access to healthy food and exercise opportunities.
- (*iv*) Clinical care variables, such as primary care physician accessibility, rates of health insurance coverage, asthma rates, and rates of mammography screening, diabetes screening, and screening for other significant health factors.
- 16 (v) Physical environmental factors, such as housing problems, 17 and other environmental exposures, such as water pollution.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
