HOUSE BILL NO. 4854

August 28, 2019, Introduced by Rep. Brann and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411y.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 411y. (1) A person who sets a contraption or device that is intentionally made or set in a manner that renders the contraption or device capable of causing injury or death to an individual and who leaves, or permits that contraption or device to
- 5 be left, in or about any place that other individuals may come into





- 1 contact with that device is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 2 imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of not more than
- 3 \$1,000.00, or both.
- 4 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
- 5 causes the injury of another individual is guilty of a felony
- 6 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of
- 7 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 8 (3) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
- 9 causes the serious impairment of a body function of another
- 10 individual is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not
- 11 more than 10 years or a fine of not more than \$7,500.00, or both.
- 12 As used in this subsection, "serious impairment of a body function"
- 13 means that term as defined in section 58c of the Michigan vehicle
- 14 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.58c.
- 15 (4) A person who violates subsection (1) and by that violation
- 16 causes the death of another individual is guilty of a felony
- 17 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 15 years or a fine of
- 18 not more than \$10,000.00, or both.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 20 after the date it is enacted into law.
