A bill to amend 1978 PA 390, entitled

"An act to regulate the time and manner of payment of wages and fringe benefits to employees; to prescribe rights and responsibilities of employers and employees, and the powers and duties of the department of labor; to require keeping of records; to provide for settlement of disputes regarding wages and fringe benefits; to prohibit certain practices by employers; to prescribe penalties and remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 14 (MCL 408.484).

- Sec. 14. (1) An Except as provided in subsection (2), an
  employer who that violates this act, including failure to pay the
  wages and fringe benefits due an employee as provided in this act,
  is quilty of a misdemeanor.
- 5 (2) An employer that violates section 13a a second or 6 subsequent time is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment 7 for not more than 2 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 for 8 each violation, or both.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days10 after the date it is enacted into law.
