A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law," $\,$

by amending section 7129 (MCL 289.7129).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7129. (1) If a food is subject to a standard established
- 2 under this chapter, it shall must be identified by the name
- 3 required by that standard. If no standard applies, the product
- 4 shall must be identified by its common or usual name. If no common
- 5 or usual name exists, the product shall must be identified by an
- 6 appropriately descriptive name that is not misleading and that





- 1 accurately identifies or describes, in as simple and direct terms
- 2 as possible, the basic nature of the food and its characterizing
- 3 ingredients or properties. A product manufactured or sold under the
- 4 provisions of this act, which is sold in closed or sealed packages
- 5 shall bear a complete label. The label shall must bear the true
- 6 name of the product as defined in this act, an ingredient statement
- 7 if the product contains more than 1 ingredient, the net weight of
- 8 the product, and the name and address of the manufacturer.
- 9 (2) Products A product sold from a bulk retail displays
- 10 display shall bear a sign or placard containing the true and
- ${f 11}$ approved name of the product. If the product contains more than 1
- 12 ingredient, an ingredient statement shall be placarded, posted, or
- 13 otherwise available for the customer in written form.
- 14 (3) Meat products A meat product using antioxidants shall
- 15 indicate on the its label, or in the absence of a label an adjacent
- 16 placard, their the presence of the antioxidants in the meat product
- 17 and their purpose.
- 18 (4) Meat products A meat product containing monosodium
- 19 glutamate, hydrolyzed vegetable protein, or any other source of
- 20 monosodium glutamate shall indicate on the its label, or, or in the
- 21 absence of a label, label an adjacent placard, in its presence.the
- 22 presence of those substances in the meat product.
- 23 (5) The meat ingredients in a meat product that specifies 1
- 24 type of meat in its name, such as including, but not limited to,
- 25 ham loaf, pork loaf, veal patties, or turkey sausage, shall must be
- 26 entirely from the species indicated in the product name. The meat
- 27 in a meat product that specifies more than 1 type of meat in its
- 28 name, such as including, but not limited to, beef and turkey
- 29 sausage, shall must be entirely from the types type of meat



- indicated, and shall contain at least 20% of each meat. A meat
 product that contains a type of meat consisting of less than 20% of
 that meat may be labeled as "(product) _____ added" or "product
- 4 with ", inserting the common name of that meat. Sausage
- 5 labeled or advertised as all meat or all beef shall not contain any
- 6 nonfat dry milk solids or dry whole milk.
- 7 (6) A person shall not label or identify as meat a laboratory-8 grown meat substitute.
- 9 (7) (6) All required words and numbers shall be legible to 10 potential customers.
