A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 136e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 136e. (1) In a criminal prosecution related to the abuse of a child under this chapter, the court may appoint, upon its own motion or upon the motion of any party, an advocate to represent the interests of an unborn human fetus. If a court orders the appointment of an advocate under this section, the court shall

- 3 decision by the court denying a request to appoint an advocate
- 4 under this section is not subject to appeal.

- 3 (4) The attorneys and law students described in subsection (3)
- 4 are eligible to serve on a voluntary basis as an advocate under
- 5 this section. A law student who participates as an advocate under
- 6 this section is subject to the Michigan Rules of Professional
- 7 Conduct.
- 8 (5) As used in this section, "law school" means a law school
- 9 accredited by the American Bar Association located in this state.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
