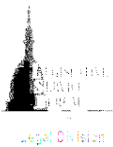
September 24, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Berman, LaGrand, O'Malley and Bolden and referred to the Committee on Oversight.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 370, entitled "Electronic open access to government act," by amending section 1 (MCL 15.451).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "electronic open access to government act".

3 (2) ~~By January 1, 2018, the~~ **The** department of technology,
4 management, and budget shall include links on this state's website



1 to **the** function, ~~and~~ **contact, and employee salary** information for
2 each executive branch department and each major division or subunit
3 within the department. The information ~~shall~~ **must** be accessible to
4 the public at no cost. Each page created or maintained under this
5 section ~~shall~~ **must** meet all of the following criteria:

6 (a) Provide for uniformity and standardization of information
7 across departments.

8 (b) Use methods that are intuitive for searching, navigating,
9 and accessing information.

10 (c) Be designed to serve the purpose of facilitating public
11 access to government services.

12 (3) The information required under this act includes all of
13 the following for each department:

14 (a) A description of the primary functions of the department
15 and the telephone number and electronic mail address for the public
16 to contact the department.

17 (b) A description of the primary functions of each major
18 division or subunit of the department and the telephone number and
19 electronic mail address for the public to contact the division or
20 subunit.

21 (c) A graphical organization chart that includes the major
22 divisions or subunits of the department and the name, position
23 title, classified or nonclassified civil service distinction, and
24 contact information for the supervisor of each major division or
25 subunit. The chart must indicate the reporting relationship of the
26 supervisors.

27 (d) **Subject to subsection (6), a list of the department's**
28 **employees that includes the name, position title, classified or**
29 **nonclassified civil service distinction, salary, and benefits**



1 information for each employee.

2 (4) Each department shall cooperate with the department of
3 technology, management, and budget in collecting and posting the
4 information required under this act. The department of technology,
5 management, and budget shall develop guidelines for the format and
6 display of the charts and other information to ensure the greatest
7 possible standardization. The department of technology, management,
8 and budget shall provide technical services and assistance to the
9 departments, as necessary, to create websites, coordinate links,
10 and maintain electronic connections necessary to implement this
11 act.

12 (5) Each department shall provide quarterly updates to the
13 information required under this act.

14 **(6) The department of technology, management, and budget shall**
15 **not post an employee's information as described in subsection**
16 **(3) (d) if it determines, based on a request made by the employee's**
17 **department, that doing so would endanger the safety of the**
18 **employee. A request made by a department under this subsection must**
19 **include sufficient information for the department of technology,**
20 **management, and budget to make a determination. The department of**
21 **technology, management, and budget shall notify each executive**
22 **branch department at least 30 days before posting information**
23 **described in subsection (3) (d), and each executive branch**
24 **department shall, promptly after receiving the notice, notify its**
25 **employees of the posting.**

26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
27 after the date it is enacted into law.
