## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5018**

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 699. At any regular election, the names of the several
  nonpartisan offices to be voted for shall must be placed on a
- 3 separate portion of the ballot containing no party designation in
- 4 the following order: justices of the supreme court, judges of the
- 5 court of appeals, judges of the circuit court, judges of the

- 2 board of trustees member, intermediate school district board
- 3 member, city officers, the following village officers in
- 4 substantially the following order in the year in which elections
- 5 for the offices are held: president, clerk, treasurer, and
- 6 trustees, and in a year in which an election for the office is
- 7 held, local school district board member, metropolitan district
- 8 officer, and district library board member, free public library
- 9 director, and township park commission member.
