THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4cc. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), beginning
- 2 January 1, 2016 through December 31, $\frac{2035}{}$, 2055, the tax under this
- ${f 3}$ act does not apply to the storage, use, or consumption of data
- 4 center equipment sold to the owner or operator of a qualified data
- 5 center or a colocated business for assembly, use, or consumption in
- 6 the operations of the qualified data center or data center





- equipment sold or provided to a person engaged in the business of
 constructing, altering, repairing, or improving real estate for
 others to the extent the data center equipment is to be affixed to
 or made a structural part of a qualified data center.
- 5 (2) The exemption under this section only continues to apply 6 after January 1, 2022, if the numbers gathered by the local 7 economic development corporations are certified and reported to the 8 department of talent and economic development labor and economic 9 opportunity and subsequently forwarded to the department and 10 demonstrate that the qualified data centers, the colocated 11 businesses, and the contractors of the qualified data centers, collectively, have, in aggregate, established in this state at 12 least 400 data center industry jobs or data center industry related 13 14 jobs, or a combination of both, since January 1, 2016. The 15 department of talent and economic development labor and economic 16 opportunity shall submit a report no later than April 1, 2022 17 related to the number of data center industry jobs or data center 18 industry related jobs that have been established since January 1, 19 2016 to the speaker and minority leader of the house of 20 representatives, the majority and minority leaders of the senate, 21 and the governor.
 - (3) The exemption under this section only continues to apply after January 1, 2026, if the numbers gathered by the local economic development corporations are certified and reported to the department of talent and economic development labor and economic opportunity and subsequently forwarded to the department and demonstrate that the qualified data centers, the colocated businesses, and the contractors of the qualified data centers, collectively, have, in aggregate, established in this state at

- (b) "Colocated business" means a person that has entered into 15 a contract with the owner or operator of a qualified data center to use or deploy data center equipment physically located within the 16 qualified data center for a period of 1 or more years. 17
- 18 (c) "Data center equipment" means only computers, servers, routers, switches, peripheral computer devices, racks, shelving, 19 20 cabling, wiring, storage batteries, back-up generators, 21 uninterrupted power supply units, environmental control equipment, 22 other redundant power supply equipment, and prewritten computer 23 software used in operating, managing, or maintaining the qualified 24 data center or the business of the qualified data center or a 25 colocated business. Data center equipment also includes any 26 construction materials used or assembled under the qualified data 27 center's proprietary method for the construction or modification of 28 a qualified data center, including, but not limited to, building 29 materials, infrastructure, machinery, wiring, cabling, devices,
