A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967,"

(MCL 206.1 to 206.713) by adding section 280.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 280. (1) For tax years that begin after December 31,
- 2 2018, a taxpayer may claim a credit against the tax imposed by this
- 3 part equal to the amount contributed in the tax year to a candidate
- 4 committee or candidate for a state elective office or a local
- 5 elective office in this state. A taxpayer shall not claim a credit





- 1 under this section for contributions made to an independent
- 2 committee or a political committee.
- 3 (2) The credit allowed under this section shall not exceed
- 4 \$50.00 for a single return or \$100.00 for a joint return.
- 5 (3) To claim the credit under this section, the taxpayer
- 6 shall, in a form and manner as prescribed by the department,
- 7 provide verification of the amounts claimed to have been
- 8 contributed during the tax year.
- 9 (4) As used in this section, "candidate", "candidate
- 10 committee", "local elective office", "independent committee",
- 11 "political committee", and "state elective office" mean those terms
- 12 as defined in the Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL
- 13 169.201 to 169.282.
