

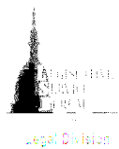
HOUSE BILL NO. 5288

December 10, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Rabhi, Pohutsky, Brenda Carter, Haadsma, Wittenberg, Pagan, Ellison, Hoadley, LaGrand, Peterson and Hammoud and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Municipal Finance.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled
"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"
by amending the title and section 502 (MCL 37.2502), the title as
amended by 1992 PA 258 and section 502 as amended by 1992 PA 124.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 TITLE
- 2 An act to define civil rights; to prohibit discriminatory
- 3 practices, policies, and customs in the exercise of those rights
- 4 based upon religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex,



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1 height, weight, familial status, ~~or~~ marital status, **or source of**
2 **income**; to preserve the confidentiality of records regarding
3 arrest, detention, or other disposition in which a conviction does
4 not result; to prescribe the powers and duties of the civil rights
5 commission and the department of civil rights; to provide remedies
6 and penalties; to provide for fees; and to repeal ~~certain~~ acts and
7 parts of acts.

8 Sec. 502. (1) A person engaging in a real estate transaction,
9 or a real estate broker or ~~salesman~~, **salesperson**, shall not on the
10 basis of religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, familial
11 status, ~~or~~ marital status, **or source of income** of a person or a
12 person residing with that person **do any of the following**:

13 (a) Refuse to engage in a real estate transaction with a
14 person.

15 (b) Discriminate against a person in the terms, conditions, or
16 privileges of a real estate transaction or in the furnishing of
17 facilities or services in connection with a real estate
18 transaction.

19 (c) Refuse to receive from a person or transmit to a person a
20 bona fide offer to engage in a real estate transaction.

21 (d) Refuse to negotiate for a real estate transaction with a
22 person.

23 (e) Represent to a person that real property is not available
24 for inspection, sale, rental, or lease when in fact it is so
25 available, or knowingly fail to bring a property listing to a
26 person's attention, or refuse to permit a person to inspect real
27 property, or otherwise make unavailable or deny real property to a
28 person.

29 (f) Make, print, circulate, post, mail, or otherwise cause to

1 be made or published a statement, advertisement, notice, or sign,
 2 or use a form of application for a real estate transaction, or make
 3 a record of inquiry in connection with a prospective real estate
 4 transaction, ~~which~~**that** indicates, directly or indirectly, an
 5 intent to make a preference, limitation, specification, or
 6 discrimination with respect to the real estate transaction.

7 (g) Offer, solicit, accept, use, or retain a listing of real
 8 property with the understanding that a person may be discriminated
 9 against in a real estate transaction or in the furnishing of
 10 facilities or services in connection ~~therewith~~**with that**
 11 **transaction.**

12 (h) Discriminate against a person in the brokering or
 13 appraising of real property.

14 (2) A person shall not deny a person access to, or membership
 15 or participation in, a multiple listing service, real estate
 16 brokers' organization or other service, organization, or facility
 17 relating to the business of selling or renting real property or to
 18 discriminate against him or her in the terms or conditions of that
 19 access, membership, or participation because of religion, race,
 20 color, national origin, age, sex, familial status, ~~or~~ marital
 21 status, **or source of income.**

22 (3) This section is subject to section 503.

23 (4) **As used in this section, "source of income" includes**
 24 **benefits or subsidy programs including housing assistance, public**
 25 **assistance, emergency rental assistance, veterans benefits, Social**
 26 **Security, supplemental security income or other retirement**
 27 **programs, and other programs administered by any federal, state,**
 28 **local, or nonprofit entity. The term does not include income**
 29 **derived in an illegal manner.**
