## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5339**

January 16, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Webber, Byrd and Brann and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1995 PA 29, entitled "Uniform unclaimed property act,"

by amending section 36a (MCL 567.256a), as added by 2016 PA 312.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 36a. (1) The administrator <del>may sell or otherwise shall</del>
- provide all unclaimed property account information described in
- 3 this section to a locator for all unclaimed accounts that remain
- 4 unclaimed for not less than 24 months after the date payment or
- 5 delivery is made described under section 20 if the value of the





- 1 unclaimed property is \$10,000.00 or more. upon written request. The
- 2 administrator shall not charge more than \$100.00 for each request.
- 3 The administrator shall provide the unclaimed property account
- 4 information in an a searchable electronic searchable or digital
- 5 format. The unclaimed property account information may shall
- 6 include all of the following:

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- (a) The name of the apparent owner or apparent owners.
- 8 (b) The complete last known address of the apparent owner or9 apparent owners, as reported by the holder.
  - (c) The relationship code, if any.
- 11 (d) The type and amount of property. and
- 12 (e) The cash value of the property if other than cash and the
  13 number of shares or items if the property is a security or a mutual
  14 fund share, including the exchange ticker symbol or fund name, if
  15 reported.
- 16 (f) The year the property was reported to the administrator.
- 17 (g) The name and contact information of the holder.
- 18 (h) A general description of the safe deposit box contents and 19 liquidation amount, if applicable.
- (2) Before the department administrator provides information
  to a locator under subsection (1), the locator shall register with
- 22 the department administrator in a form and manner determined by the
- 23 department administrator and pay a fee to the department
- 24 administrator of \$1,200.00. The fees collected under this
- 25 subsection shall be used by the department administrator to
- 26 register and monitor locators under this act. The locator shall
- 27 renew its registration and pay a fee of \$1,200.00 every 4 years. To
- 28 register, a locator shall provide the department administrator a
- 29 primary business address and telephone number, and the name,



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- 1 telephone number, and electronic mail address of the individual who
- 2 will be the primary point of contact with the department.
- 3 administrator. A locator is ineligible for registration if, within
- 4 the immediately preceding 10 years, the individual, a current
- 5 officer or owner of an entity, or a current employee of the
- 6 individual or entity who performs or directs locator services was
- 7 convicted of a felony involving dishonesty, deceit, fraud, or a
- 8 breach of fiduciary duty.
- 9 (3) A locator who receives unclaimed property account
- 10 information from the administrator under subsection (1) shall not
- 11 distribute that information to other locators or any other person,
- 12 other than the apparent—owner, for compensation.
- 13 (4) If an owner has entered into a written agreement that
- 14 authorizes a locator registered with the administrator under this
- 15 act, to claim the unclaimed property on the owner's behalf or if
- 16 the owner has sold the right to claim the unclaimed property to a
- 17 locator, the administrator shall make distribution of the property
- 18 or money in accordance with that written agreement. The written
- 19 agreement must be executed by the owner and must be filed with the
- 20 administrator.
