A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 609c (MCL 436.1609c), as added by 2017 PA 130.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 609c. (1) A manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer
- 2 as provided under section 203(19) or a wholesaler may refund to a
- 3 retailer the amount the retailer paid for beer or wine, as
- 4 applicable, or a manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as
- 5 provided under section 203(19) or a wholesaler may replace that
- 6 beer or wine for any of the following reasons:





- 1 (a) The beer or wine is outdated.
- 2 (b) The beer or wine is defective.
- 3 (c) An error in the beer or wine delivered.
- 4 (d) The beer or wine may no longer be lawfully sold.
- 5 (e) The termination of the retailer's business.
- 6 (f) The formula, proof, label, or container of the beer or
- 7 wine is changed.
- 8 (g) The beer or wine is discontinued.
- 9 (h) The retailer is only open a portion of the year and the10 beer or wine is likely to spoil during the off-season.
- 12 manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided under
 13 section 203(19) or a wholesaler may refund to a retailer the amount
 14 the retailer paid for the beer.
- 15 (3) A manufacturer that sells direct to a retailer as provided

 16 under section 203(19) or a wholesaler may only issue a refund or

 17 replacement under this section for beer or wine that the

 18 manufacturer or wholesaler sold to the retailer.
